Climate and weather.

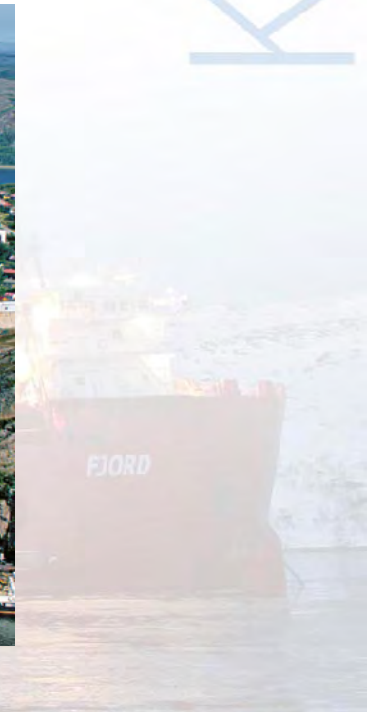
- Kirkenes has a stable, calm and dry continental climate with absence of extreme coastal weather conditions.
- The Kirkenes climate secures excellent regularity of all communications.
- The Kirkenes port and industrial sites are accessible and operative at all times.

Kirkenes Port.

- Kirkenes is Norway's main entrance to and from Russia.
- Port depths are more than 25 meters. Quay depths at present 13,8 meters.
- Competitive full port services are available to foreign and domestic vessels.
- The Kirkenes port is an important service and base port for Russian commercial vessels.
- The port has unlimited expansion and development potentials and is continuously developed to meet new requirements.
- The Kirkenes port is appointed by the Norwegian Coastal Administration as the only Norwegian Border area port suitable for petroleum processing sites and offshore supply services.



Industrial site areas.

A study made by Rambøll describes the following large industrial site areas in the Port of Kirkenes:

**Prestøya Kirkenesbase/Nor Lines Kirkenes/
Kirkenesterminalen** -50 acres
(appr. 200.000 square meters)

Sydvaranger - 250 acres
(appr. 1.000.000 square meters)

Other possible sites - 3700 acres
(appr. 15.000.000 square meters)

- By air – via Oslo, the fastest route to the North. Several daily 2 hours nonstop flights. Aircraft Boeing 737.
- By road – excellent and always open road connections with Russia, Finland, Sweden and the rest of Norway and Europe.
- By sea - daily calls by the Norwegian Coastal Express and frequent calls by cargo vessels serving the Norwegian and Northwest Russian coast.
- By rail – 40 km by road to the Russian continental railway network.
- Ship to Ship petroleum transfer operations
- Russian Consulate General

About 400 Russian and International vessels call at the Kirkenes Port each year for:

- Repair, maintenance, outfitting or conversion purposes.
- Shore Base services.
- Crew changes.
- Procurement of fuel, water, provisions, waste handling etc.

The crew of Russian vessels are welcomed and served in their own language by the local ships agents, immigration authorities, health, welfare, church, sport, library services etc.

Shops, hotels and restaurants are manned with Russian and English speaking service personnel.
